



Main Street Apopka Art Competition Entry Rules

Eligibility: Participants must be 16 years of age or older, of all skill levels, and must be from or reside in Apopka.

Submission Deadline: The submission deadline is 5:00 pm on February 28, 2024.

Theme: "The Citrus Grove Chapel: A Peacock's Tale By The River." This inspirational theme should be a visual celebration of Apopka's natural beauty and resources existing in partnership with the human influences of downtown business.

Submission Method: Only online submissions will be accepted. Artwork can be submitted via the website form at [www.mainstreetapopka.com/art], or by email to mainstreetapopka@gmail.com, or through direct messaging on Facebook or Instagram.

Accepted Mediums: Only traditional artwork will be accepted. Digital, photography, sculpted, or 3D printed artwork will not be considered.

Content Guidelines: Artwork containing sensitive material, including but not limited to gore, nudity, slang, profane language, discrimination, etc., will result in automatic disqualification.

Size Guidelines: Canvas size can range from 8.5"x11" to 24"x36."

Drop-Off Location: If chosen as a finalist, artwork must be delivered to Main Street Apopka for live viewing display at a date, time, and location to be coordinated.

Featured Image for Downtown Apopka: The winning artwork has the chance to be featured prominently by Main Street Apopka as the image representing Downtown Apopka, providing unparalleled visibility for the artist.

Grand Prize

Artwork Display: The winning artwork will be displayed at rotating local businesses throughout the year, allowing the community to appreciate and admire the artist's work.

Gift Card: A gift card to a local downtown business will be awarded to the winner, supporting the local economy and encouraging further exploration of the vibrant downtown area.

Future Royalty Distribution: The winner will be eligible for future royalty distribution, the details of which will be determined based on the commercial use of the winning artwork.

First Right of Refusal: The winner will have the first right of refusal on Main Street Apopka art projects, such as murals and other paying gigs, providing exciting opportunities for future collaborations and commissions.

By entering the competition, participants agree to comply with these rules and any additional guidelines provided by Main Street Apopka. Failure to adhere to these rules may result in disqualification. The grand prize is designed to recognize and reward the talent and creativity of the winning artist, while also promoting the cultural richness of Apopka's downtown area.
